QUESTIONS	DO THIS	CHANGES YOU MADE
Does the introduction hook the reader's attention, give background information, and clearly state the thesis?	<p><b>Circle</b> the hook.</p> <p><b>Underline</b> background information.</p> <p><b>Bracket</b> the thesis statement.</p>	
Are the main ideas (topic/claim sentences) and supporting details relevant to the thesis?	<p><b>Highlight</b> the topic sentences (claim sentences).</p> <p><b>Squiggly line</b> the explanations.</p>	
Are facts and ideas stated mainly in the writer's own words? Are the textual support explanations elaborate?	<p><b>Star</b> sentences containing direct quotations. If more than one third of the sentences are starred, revise.</p>	
Are sources credited when necessary? Are citations correctly placed and punctuated?	<p><b>Place check marks</b> by material from the databases that require documentation.</p>	
Does the conclusion restate the thesis? Is the Works Cited or Reference List complete and formatted correctly?	<p><b>Bracket</b> the restatement of the thesis.</p> <p><b>Place an X</b> by each of the bibliography citations.</p>	
Do many of the sentences begin in the same familiar subject-verb pattern?	<p><b>Underline</b> the subject and verb of each sentence. If three consecutive start in the same way, switch it up.</p>
